The entrance foyer and pre-function areas offer privacy with two technology nooks that have charging stations and TV’s and were built using sustainable materials including bamboo and American walnut flooring.

With three acres of poolscape, including a serene adults-only pool and hot tub, the options are endless when it comes to relaxing after a long day. Those looking to destress and recharge can take refuge in the 19,000-square-foot Stillwater Spa or head out to one of the four pools to soak up some Florida sunshine.
