Guests can choose to jump in and snorkel or simply soak up the sun and scenic views. Near Buccoo Reef, travelers will find the clear, shallow turquoise waters of nylon pool ideal for swimming. It has been said that a dip in the nylon pool will make you look 10 years younger. After working up an appetite snorkeling and soaking up the sun, lunch is served at one of the lively beachside restaurants at Pigeon Point. Those who wish to extend their visit to Tobago can book a full-day tour, which includes additional sightseeing. Tickets start at US\$225 per person for groups as small as two people. Ticket price includes ground transfers, flights, lunch, Pigeon Point entry fee, glass bottom boat and snorkel tour, all with a personal guide. Pan Art Tour
