<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Opened January 2008, the Hyatt Regency Trinidad is the Caribbean's premier meeting, convention, business, event and leisure travel property. The 428-room hotel is situated in the Port of Spain International Waterfront Development. The Hyatt's versatile event space showcases a 16,000 square-foot Regency Ballroom and a 10,000 square-foot Port of Spain Ballroom with translation facilities. Other guest facilities include one full-service restaurant, a lobby bar and lounge, a fitness center and the 9,000 square-foot Spa Esencia. Hyatt Regency Trinidad provides a relaxing escape for business travelers with an infinity pool and terrace overlooking the Gulf of Paria.
<b>LOCATION</b>	Trinidad is home to Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago's capital city. The country's economy is strongly based on petroleum production and exports while Port of Spain serves as an established base for companies doing international business in Latin America and the



Caribbean. Currently the capital city is undergoing major retail, hospitality and industrial development.

In 2007, Trinidad and Tobago was ranked second among the ten richest countries in the Caribbean. Additionally, Port of Spain and Piarco International Airport serve as gateways to Tobago's leisure tourism market along with destinations throughout Latin America and the Caribbean.

Trinidad is a spirited destination with an exciting mix of cultural activities, a multi-ethnic population, eco adventure and culinary delights.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**
