DESCRIPTION	<p>The AAA Four Diamond Hyatt Regency Coconut Point Resort & Spa features world-class golf, a 19,000-square-foot spa, the OpenTable® Diners' Choice Award-winning Tanglewood restaurant and an extravagant series of water features, including multiple pools ranging from 2,700 to 5,000 square feet and a 140-foot corkscrew slide. The 454-room resort, which holds Florida Green Lodging's prestigious Three Palm eco-friendly certification, is the ideal base camp between Naples and Ft. Myers. Located on 26 acres overlooking the breathtaking Estero Bay Aquatic Preserve, the resort offers convenient access to both destinations as well as a private island for a more secluded retreat. In 2015, the property was recognized as the <i>Expedia</i> Insiders' Select Top Hotel Worldwide and <i>Orbitz Worldwide</i> Best in Stay. The resort's new waterpark features three waterslides, a lazy river, a three-story water tower and a recreation area with a food truck serving an ever-changing menu of local cuisine. This expansion rounds out the resort's aquatic adventure offerings, including the pristine private beach on Big Hickory Island, which offers the opportunity to relax on the beach, hunt for sharks' teeth, collect more than 400 types of seashells, kayak or paddleboard along the beautiful shoreline and observe native and migrating wildlife.</p>

- Unwind during happy hour at **Corkscrew**, offering a tropical atmosphere and friendly service. Guests can relax at this outdoor location with the convenience of a full bar and a variety of delicious menu items.

- Each evening offers a different signature cocktail at **Mangroves** cocktail lounge. Located right off the lobby in a comfortable and contemporary setting, Mangroves is the place for guests and locals to mingle.
- Relax in the overstuffed sofas in the **Belvedere Room** after a busy day around the resort. Challenge your family or friends to a game of checkers or backgammon.
- Host a private dinner with up to 40 guests at **The Cove at Tarpon Bay** private dining room. An extension of the Tarpon Bay restaurant, guests will enjoy a fantastic view of the Banyan Courtyard while sipping a glass of wine from the award-winning wine list. The room also features a 55" flat screen TV monitor for presentations.
- Find everything from your favorite Starbucks brew to an ice cold beer at **Cool Beans**. This eclectic location offers a variety of items, including beach cooler rentals and complimentary DVDs for guests to enjoy.

ACTIVITIES

Guests can explore museums, national parks, wildlife refuge and swamps or take part in various activities including kayaking, boat rentals, fishing excursions, bird watching, private charter sailing, parasailing and airboat tours.

- The resort's **three-acre waterpark** includes three brand new three-story waterslides, including two speed slides and one inner-tube slide, and 1,095 feet of heated lazy river pool. The expansive waterpark also features a 2,700-square-foot Waterfall Pool with cool water cascades, 5,000-square-foot heated Adventure Pool with a 140-foot corkscrew slide and free-form lagoon-style pool, as well as an adults-only heated pool with an adjacent hot tub.
- Take a short 15-minute water taxi ride to the exclusive **Big Hickory Island Beach** to enjoy the natural setting of this calming environment. Enjoy catching a glimpse of dolphins, turtles or manatees while learning local history and the ecology of the estuarine systems.
- Explore **Everglades National Park**, the largest subtropical wilderness in the United States and spot rare and endangered species including the American crocodile, Florida panther, and West Indian manatee. Full and half day tours are available daily.
- Have a picnic on the **Delnor-Wiggins Pass State Recreation Area's** mile-long stretch of white sugar sand, which has been rated as one of the best beaches in the nation. The beach is also popular for sunbathing, swimming, beachcombing and snorkeling.

- For less than \$10, visitors can explore **Naples Botanical Garden**'s beautifully restored natural habitats filled with cultivated tropical gardens.
- Many people visit Southwest Florida for shelling as the beaches because the currents bring shells from the Caribbean to local shore. Visitors can expect to find horse conchs, calico scallops, banded tulips, starfish, corkscrew-shaped augers, sand dollars, the rare lion's paw and the rarer Junonia shell among hundreds of others.

GOLF COURSE
